2. Eligibility

Open to all CR-914 registered with the class are invited to participate by the Chesapeake Bay Model Racing Association in the CR-914 National Regatta. We will limit the entries to 34 competitors to maximize the sailing time. All participants must be members of the CR-914 Class and the American Model Yachting Association. (AMYA) New, owner boat registration is \$10. This payment may be made at Registration. We encourage you to join the AMYA but will have complimentary Memberships available pondside.

3. Pre-registration/Entry Fee

All participants must pre-register for this Regatta by completing the Entry Form and submitting it to the Committee for receipt no later than August 1, 2023. Each entry shall be accompanied by the entry fee. Any entry received after this date will be subject to a \$15.00 late fee.
